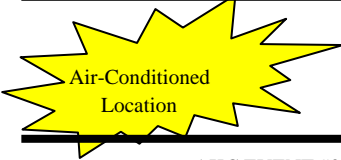

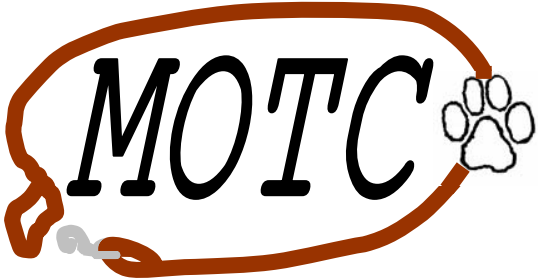

\$18.00 Non-Regular class as the first entry of each dog on Saturday

(First entry includes a 50 cent AKC recording Fee and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each entry and \$2.00 surcharge for MTSU for each dog entered)

**Rally:** \$22.00 for the first entry of each dog each day

\$15.00 for each additional entry of the same dog each day in Rally

(Each entry includes \$3.00 AKC recording fee and \$2.00 surcharge for MTSU for each dog entered)

### INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. 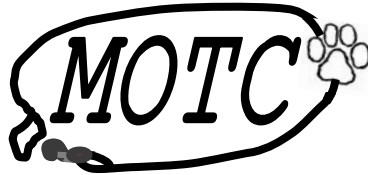

- Consult Judging Program for the time of judging
- Qualifying Score required for all prizes and awards in regular classes except as listed
- Dogs should be present at least one half hour before they are to be judged and will be excused immediately after judging
- The word "DOG" includes both sexes
